Conference and Qualifications

Cottey is a conference member of the Association of Independent Institutions (AII) and competes nationally in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA).

Cottey's membership in the NAIA offers athletes a high level of competition from teams in numerous states across the nation. A student must meet two of the following criteria to compete at the NAIA level:

1. Achieve a minimum of 18 on the ACT or 970 on the SAT
2. Achieve a minimum overall high school GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
3. Graduate in the top half of her high school class

Additionally, student-athletes must pass 12 credit hours in both the fall and spring semesters to remain eligible.
