

LIFE OF A SOCIAL WORKER

• Nearly 90% of mental health workers seek personal therapy before, during, and after their professional training

• Social Workers have the highest rates of injuries and illnesses of all occupations

• Caseloads range from 10 to 100 children per Child Welfare worker



• The Child Welfare field is known for high turnover ratesthis results in low staff morale and excessive workloads

WHY SOCIAL WORKERS ARE NECESSARY


In social work cases where there were not enough social workers, the following circumstances have occured:

- A study of 155 girls ages 4-17 in foster care revealed that
- Bruce Jackson (19) and three other children (9–14) were found scavenging

84% had been sexually abused while 81% had been physically abused

• 9 year old Byron Cassanova was visited by a social worker who was concerned about his living situation, four days later he committed suicide through trash for food in Collingswood, NJ, even after being visited by DYFS

• Raheem WIlliams (7) and Tyrone Hills (4) found in the basement of a house along with the body of Raheem's twin brother in a storage container in Newark, NJ
