AFFORDABILITY

Cottey works diligently to ensure attending college is affordable for its students. We work especially hard with students who have financial needs. **In fact, 45% of our 2022 class graduated with no debt!**

Don't be misled! The low sticker price of public universities may make them look like a bargain, but they often show only tuition costs, leaving out room and board. Cottey's scholarships, aid, and grants from the P.E.O. Sisterhood bring our average cost to attend below most public and private schools.

Below is our average annual cost, **including tuition, fees, and room and board after financial aid is applied**, compared to other types of institutions:
