


# **STUDENTS**

# **FORMERS**

In keeping with the mission of the CCAA, the board engaged and **connected** with former board members. Formers participated in quarterly Zoom calls and shared their experiences since leaving the board in the Formers newsletter.

A Formers Facebook page was created to allow for engaging and interacting with alumnae who served on the board. Of the 79 Formers, 13% participated in Formers Zoom calls and an additional 8% expressed interest to join in the future.

The CCAA Board emailed parents / guardians for 325 deposited students (including 62 legacies) to share our thoughts on the Cottey experience, our higher education and employment outcomes, Cottey affordability, campus safety, and the post-graduation Cottey network...all with the purpose to compel them to select Cottey as their official college choice.




# STUDENT CENTER / CHAPEL INITIATIVE

The earnings of the *Cottey Campus Visit Fund* are to be used to provide assistance to perspective students' campus visits.


The CCAA Board gave \$10,000 to establish the endowment.

Proceeds from sales go to CCAA-sponsored projects. This year's sales also supported the Office of Enrollment and the Cottey C Seniors.


