The field of specialization is open, but candidates must demonstrate the ability to teach the US history survey as well as courses in US women's history, historical methods, and one other geographic area outside of the US, excluding Europe. Annual teaching load is 4-4 and includes courses at the introductory, intermediate, and advanced levels. The successful candidate will have a record of effective teaching and active scholarship and have the Ph.D. in US history in hand by the start of the contract.
