In early March, Career Services facilitated student participation in two career fairs, held at Pittsburg State University (March 4th) and Missouri State University (March 5th). Prior to the fairs, students attended a workshop to refine their resumes, practice their elevator pitches, and learn essential networking and professional attire skills. The fairs enabled valuable connections with potential employers and internship hosts.

When polled, 100% of students responded ‘yes’ to the question, “Did you secure any job interviews, offers, or information about a potential job/internship that you will follow up on as a result of the Career Fair?”

When asked if they would attend the Career Fair again, 50% of students answered ‘definitely,’ 25% of students answered ‘probably,’ and 25% of students answered that they were seniors.
