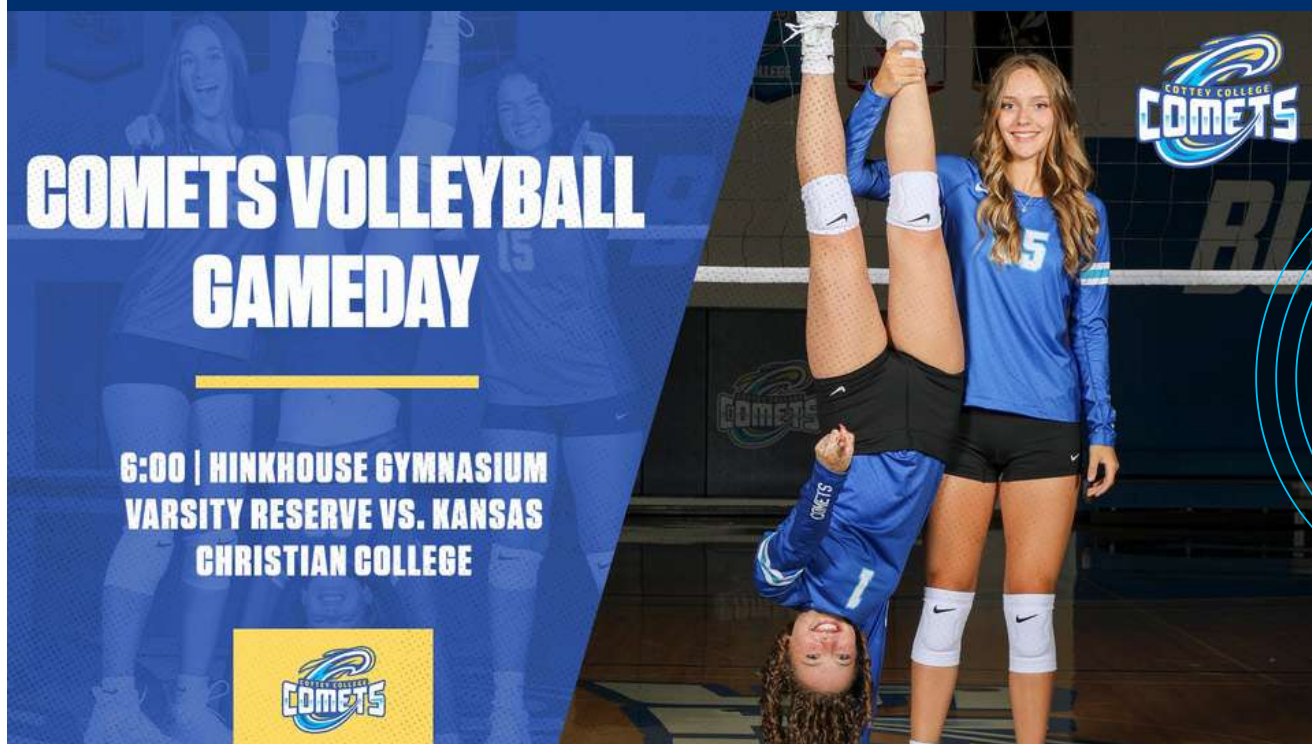
Nancy Kohn
